SPECIFIC FACILITIES PROVIDED FOR WOMEN IN TERMS OF:-

(a) Safety and Security:

Gender Sensitisation: An Introduction

Gender Sensitisation is one fundamental requirement for the normal development of an individual. Without being sensitive to the needs of a particular gender, an individual may refrain from understanding the opposite gender. The need for this sensitivity has been felt and realized through times immemorial and in almost all kinds of human existence, across the globe. But somehow in recent times, a much stronger need is felt and realised to talk and discuss about this sensitive topic both on a personal and professional front. It is felt that individuals need to be more open-minded, rational and unbiased in their thoughts and actions. There is an urgent need to shatter the load of our orthodox beliefs and biases values to accentuate the progressive existence of both the genders. Gender sensitivity can help root out negative attitude about gender and sexuality; it helps us de-condition ourselves to make way for more progressive values. Although the law mandates gender sensitisation in educational institutions, not everyone takes it seriously. In a world preoccupied with assigning the onus of safety to survivors and marginalised groups, an effective gender sensitisation session should raise awareness among everyone. Gender sensitisation can be understood in simple terms as a modification of behaviour by addressing issues of gender inequality. Govt. P.G. College for Women, Rohtak is a powerhouse of gender sensitisation as it is the college from where thousands of students graduate every year and carry with them a 'mindset' trained here. The college is committed to gender sensitisation which is reflected in its annual gender sensitisation action plan.

Gender Sensitisation Action Plan

- To sensitise the young girls by the inclusion of topics related to Gender sensitisation for the girl students.
- To conduct counselling sessions for the girl students.

Objectives of Gender Sensitisation

- To instill positive values so as to erase biases in the young developing minds as they progress towards the fair and unbiased society.
 - To create an inclusive gender diverse workplace with fair practices.
- To work towards modification of behaviour by raising awareness of gender equality concerns.

- To appreciate the fact that the rights of every woman is as important as her male counterpart.
- To create an open-minded society.
- To familiarise them with their constitutional rights and safeguards.
- To provide mentorship.
- To establish a formal mechanism to deal with the issues related to sexual discrimination and abuse.
- To conduct gender awareness and sensitisation activities on regular basis.
- To foster Student's Code of Conduct that promotes gender parity at the governance level.

- 6. Procedure to be followed -The amount has been allocated by the O/o of Director General Higher Education. Haryana. Panehkula depending upon the number of students and will be drawn by the Principal of the concerned College, through the Treasury. Record will be maintained by the DDOs concerned. The Department will monitor the progress of scheme for effective implementation.
- The Colleges where the OD powers are allocated to Principal of a neighboring College, that incharge Principal will draw the amount.
- The Officer responsible for implementing the scheme and the DDO shall strictly follow the guidelines and objective given below:-

Guidelines

- The students will be engaged for Office, Lab. Library, IT related works
- The students should be engaged by a duly constituted committee of 2 Senior Lecturer of college.

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- The meritorious students should be given priority over the others and thereafter principal may ensure that the priority should be given to the needy students.
- The students will only be engaged when the college council certifies that there is need
 of engaging students due to shortage of ministerial staff.
 - v. Per hour payment to the student be duly verified by the HOD of the concerned Department/ Office and certified by the committee constituted thereof.

All the Principal will strictly abide the above guidelines.

Objects of the Scheme

To providing an opportunity for earning while learning so that spirit of work culture and confidence is inculcated in the students. Concurrently enterprising students would be provided financial support, counseling and a holistic opportunity to learn and plan their careers by awarding individual grants for undertaking a certain kind of study. For this apart from the financial help, a student would be treated as an intern of the State and would be helped extensively by facilitating his/her overall development.

- The scheme envisages engaging students in small tasks in the college such as in a. Laboratories: It will inculcate in them a sense of responsibility towards handling. maintenance and up keep of all the equipments, storage of material and other ancillary tasks in the laboratories. For this the preference would be given to the students from science streams so that they can perform their duties along with studies/ experimentations. This assistance in laboratory will be in regular college hours.
 - b. Library: Library Jobs involving them in maintaining and drawing catalogues. arrangement and display of books, stock verification, tasks related to repair of damage books, issue and return of the books at the counter etc.
 - c. Assistance in the Computer room of the College. Assistance in the office work of the college and any other suitable job in the college campus.

In accordance with objects of the scheme, to inculcate the work culture & community service amongst the students, the following action plans are proposed to take care of the people and libraries of old age & orphanage hence of Haryana as under:-

Action Plan:

- 1. Taking Care of Old Age and Orphan Age People:- A group of volunteer students will be formed under the supervision of NSS Programme Officer who will be Nodal Officer of this scheme. The group will comprise NSS Volunteers, YRC Students, NCC Cadets and other dedicated and disciplined students. These students shall take care of minimum one person in Old Age Homes, Orphan Age Homes, Open Shelter Homes and Observation Homes. Nodal Officer will prepare the list of such old age and orphan age persons and allot each of them to every voluntary student. Each such student shall visit these Homes minimum twice a week and may interact with the allotted person telephonically for rest of the days keeping in view the COVID pandemic situation. They shall help in procuring medicines for them and also help in other important work of old age persons or orphans. Students may also be directed to study the challenges of persons living in Old age/orphan age homes and learn from their experiences.
- 2. Adoption of Libraries at Old Age and Orphan Age Homes:- Libraries are proposed to be started in some villages and all Mahagrams, blocks, sub-divisions and old age & orphanages of Haryana State. A group of volunteer students will be formed to take care of these libraries under the supervision of Youth Red Cross (YRC) Counsellor or NSS Programme Officer. The group will comprise YRC Students. NSS Volunteers and NCC Cadets. Nodal Officer will allot each assigned library to a group of 3 students who shall visit the library for two days each on rotation basis.
- 3. Taking Care of Old Age People in Rural Area:- About two third population of India is living in villages. There is a need to aware rural people about hygiene and other important schemes of the Government about their welfare. A group of NSS Volunteers, NCC Cadets, YRC members and other volunteer students from rural area will work under the supervision of NSS/NCC officer who will be Nodal Officer the Scheme. Each such student will take care of at least one old age person living in nearby area or village.

Selection of Volunteer Students

Selection of volunteer students will be made by a duly constituted committee of the college under the chairmanship of the Principal, Principals are requested to ensure that the priority should be given to the needy students who are disciplined and dedicated.

The selection criteria for the scheme would be to invite application from the students of all the classes alongwith bio-data to be finalized by a committee of 2 Senior Lecturer and Principal of the College. The selection process would be transparent and the Principal will send the minutes of

All the Nodal Officers of above three schemes will ensure the regular reporting and feedback system. Whatsapp groups for each of the above activities may be formed by the Nodal Officers for the smooth functioning and submit the report to his office.

For all these jobs students would be paid of Rs. 100/- per hour (maximum number of six hours to be permitted per week per students i.e. Rs. 600/- per week per student) so that a student 10.







Tobacco use is the single largest cause of preventable deaths and illness worldwide and it kills half of its users prematurely, mostly in their most reproductive age. Tobacco use is a major risk factor for Cancer, Cardiovascular Diseases (CVD), Diabetes, Chronic Lung Disease, stroke, infertility, blindness, Tuberculosis (TB), Oral Cavities etc.. ln lndia, over 13.00 lakh people die from tobacco use every year, i.e., about 3500 people die in lndia everyday due to tobacco use.

Various Rules are notified for effective regulation of tobacco products from time to time. These are provided for prohibition of:

- Smoking in public places, sales of tobacco products to and by minors,
- Sale of tobacco products within 100 yards of educational institutions and,
- Direct and indirect advertising and promotion of tobacco products.

Tobacco Control activities- College undertakes tobacco control activities from time to time. These activities are as under:

- Assemblies for taking pledge against tobacco,
- Poster/slogan/essay/quiz/debate competitions and street plays etc. Posters so developed with information about the harmful effects of tobacco are displayed at prominent places in the educational institution.
- The institute encourages tobacco control initiatives by students /teachers/ other staff and certificates of appreciation or awards are given to those who take initiative and do good work in this regard.
- The institute invites the local law enforcement authorities /and health authorities to be the part of assembly and deliver an address on tobacco control.

Types of Activities:-


