(a) Safety and Security:

- ❖ Safety and Security is considered as the prime responsibility of the college. GPGCW, Rohtak feels pride in providing a safe and secure campus to the girl students and female staff.
- ❖ While the college has a total of 3 gates, one main gate and 2 sub gates, only one is used for regular passage with security guards manning the gate at all times. The other two sub gates remain locked, except on special occasions and with monitoring.
- ❖ The high walls with Barbed Metal Fencing Wire(KantaTaar) of the campus also prevent the trespassers from entering the college premises.
- ❖ There are web cameras installed in every nook and corner of the college.
- ❖ Durga Shakti Van regularly visits in the college campus for providing security to the girls.
- ❖ Campus Safety and Security is a team work that involves the constitution of various committees such as Anti- Sexual Harassment Committee/Internal Complaint Committee/Grievance Redressal Cell, Proctorial and Discipline Committee and Anti- Ragging Committee.

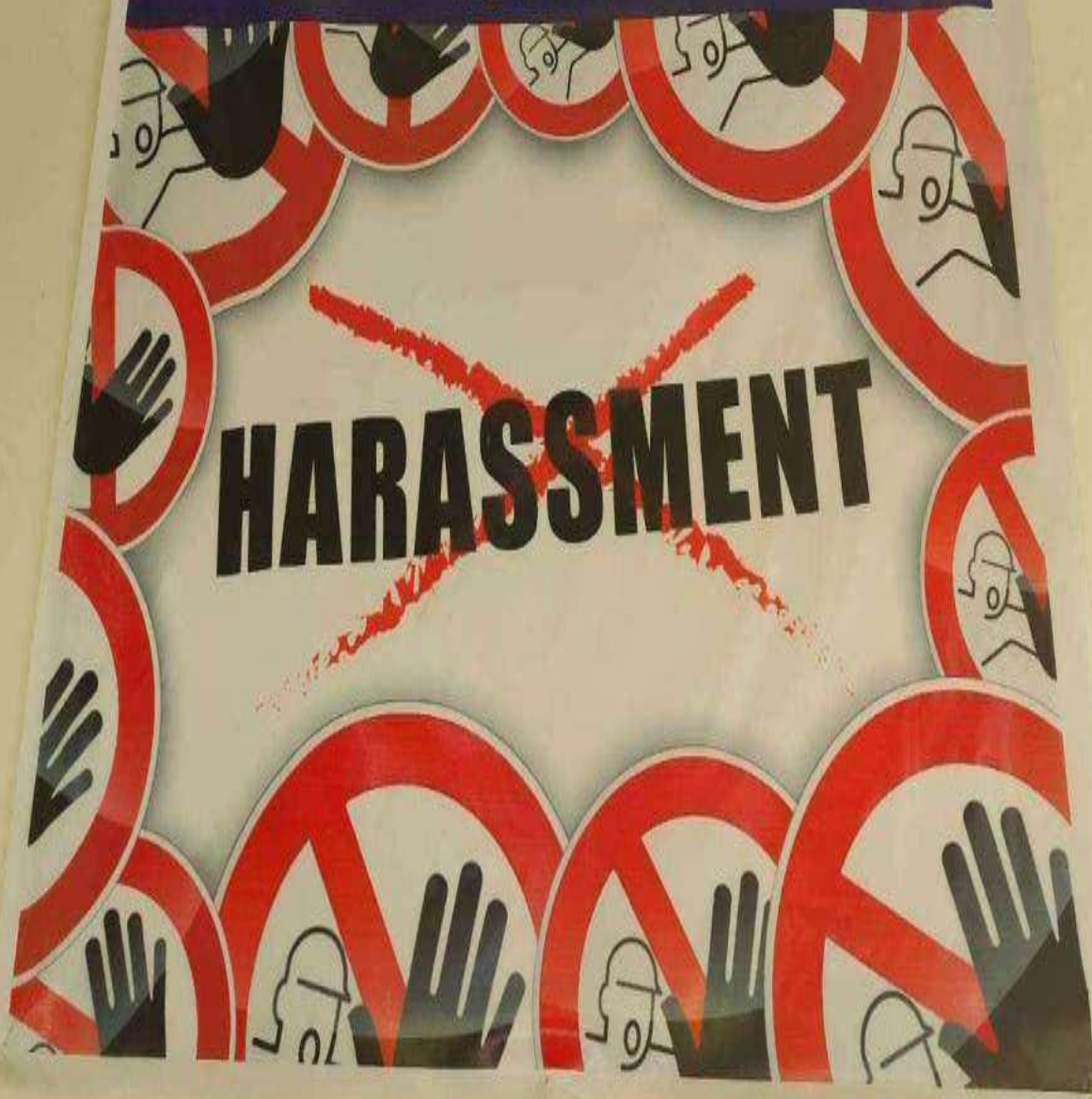

ANTI RAGGING CELL/SQUAD

Government P.G. College for Women, Rohtak has a transparent mechanism of timely redressal of student grievances related with ragging cases as per UGC norms. Anti-Ragging Cell works in the college to curb the menace of ragging and generate an atmosphere of discipline in the campus. The Cell keeps a continuous watch over ragging to prevent its occurrence. Students are informed and guided about the ragging through banners, general assembly, mentors and are advised not to indulge in any type of ragging of students in the college campus as strict disciplinary action will be taken against such type of mischievous students. The members of the college Anti Ragging Squad are also introduced to students in the orientation at the beginning of the session so that if any student is found active in ragging then it can be immediately reported to the members of the Anti-Ragging Squad.

Students of second and final year are advised and guided to take care of the incumbent students and informed time and again about the repercussions of indulging in ragging or any other anti- social activities. Regular interaction and counseling with the students is done to detect early signs of ragging. An active final year student is also nominated as the member of Anti- Ragging Cell as a student representative. Surprise inspection at hostels, canteen, classrooms, toilets etc. is done by the members of the Anti-Ragging Cell. It is a matter of pleasure for Principal, staff and students of GPGCW, Rohtak that in the last 6 years from 2016-17 to 2023-24, no complaint was lodged regarding ragging in the college campus.

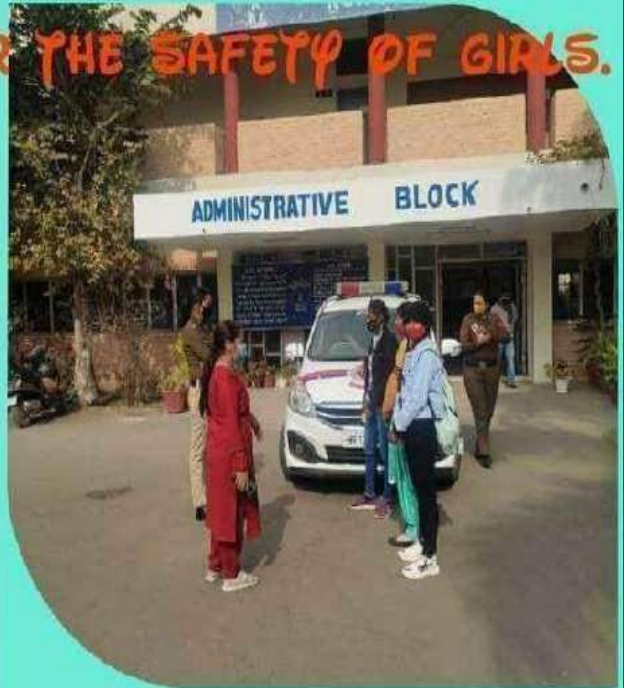

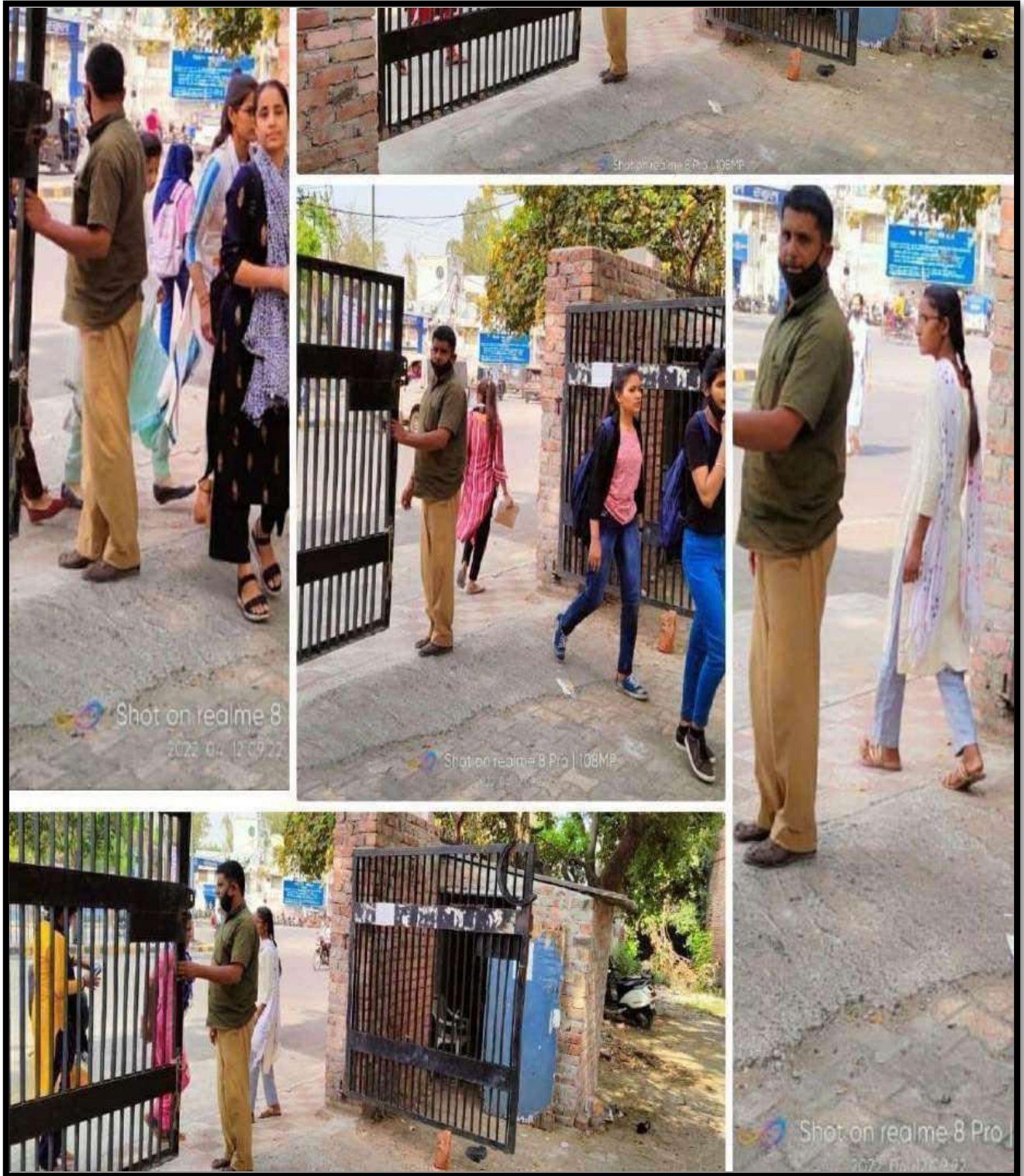

- Strict implementation of admission policies for people with disabilities according to guidelines of UGC. Admission Policy of the institute offers 3% reservation for persons with disabilities in all courses of State Quota.

Campus infrastructure of GPGCW, Rohtak is more accessible for people with disabilities. The institute provides the following facilities:

- Ramps.
- Railings.
- Tactile Pathways.
- Accessible Washrooms for disable students and staff.
- A separate place of parking for disabled persons to avoid any type of difficulties in parking vehicles.

- ❖ Reading source in Braille. “*Sparsh*” Hindi monthly magazine is therein our library for Disabled persons.
- ❖ An International Braille News paper in Hindi is also available in library in every 15 days of the month.

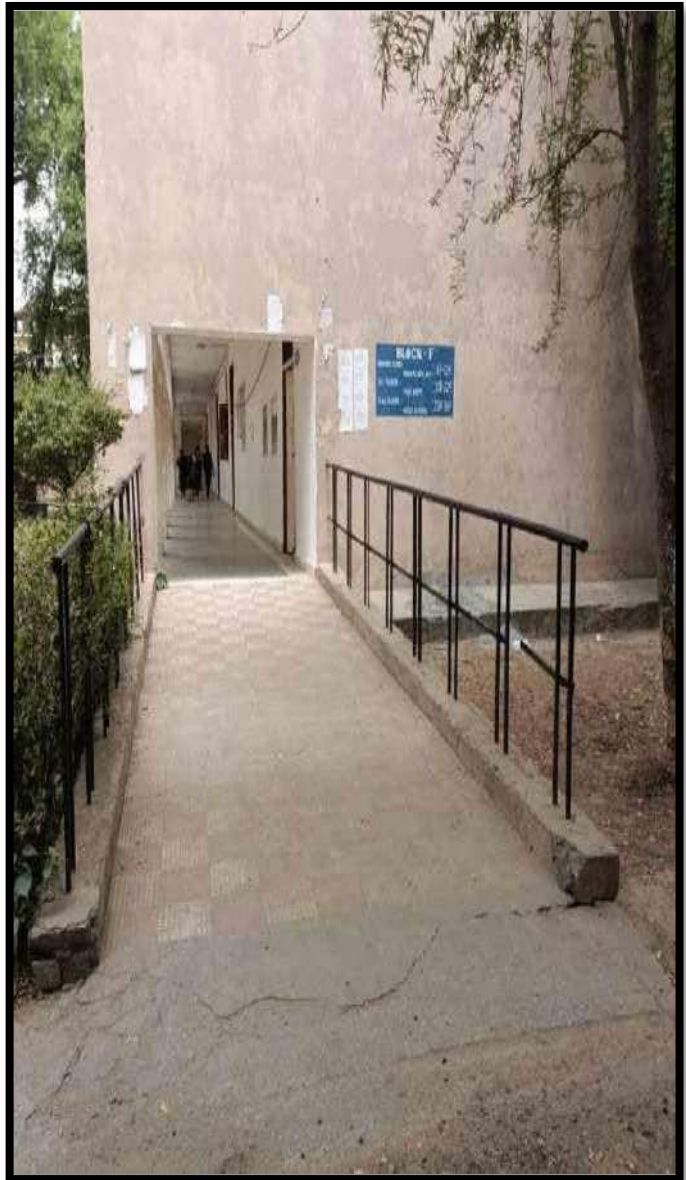
- ❖ Disabled friendly sign posts are displayed for their convenience.

Bus Pass Committee

The Haryana Government has finalized a free transport scheme for girl student to encourage their enrolment in institutes of higher education. The need for the facility was felt as girls were unable to pursue higher studies and some could not opt for courses of their choice as their parents were reluctant to send them to college located as a distance. At G.P.G.C.W. Rohtak, this service started in October, 2011 as per the guidelines of DHE with nominal charges. 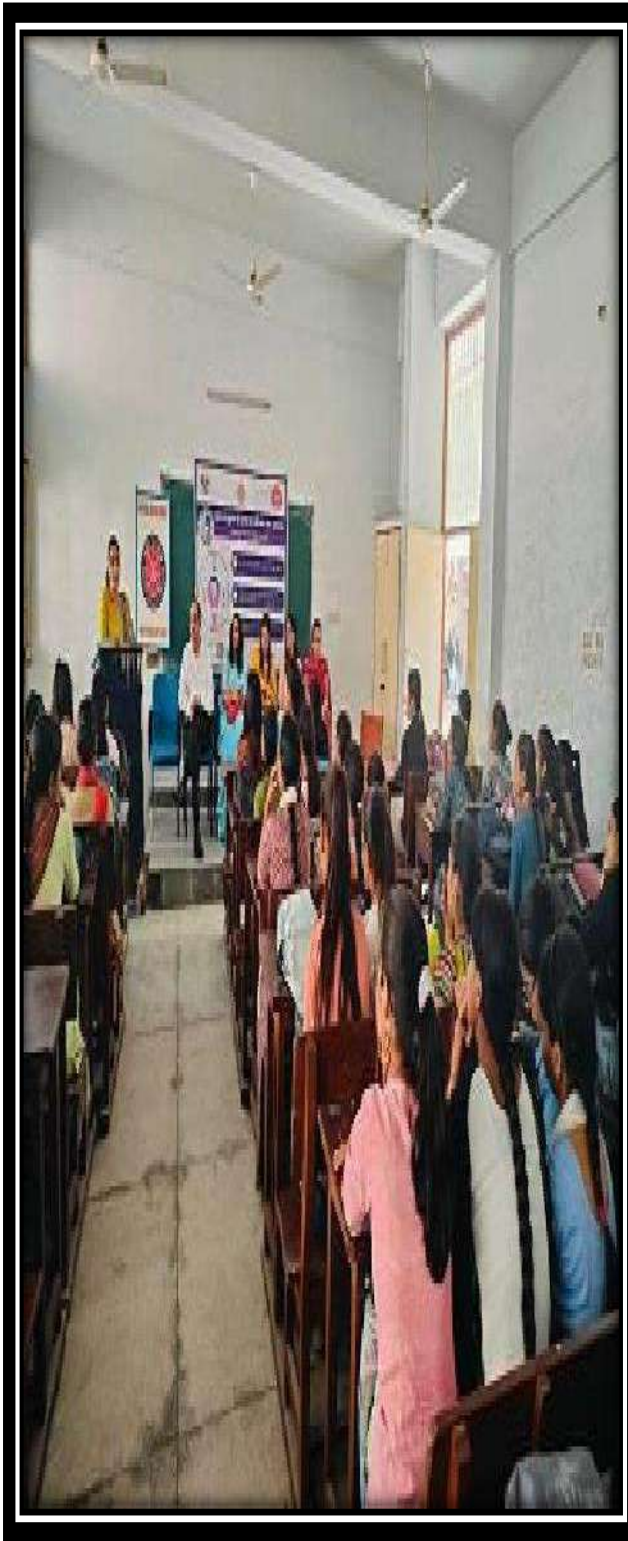

National Cadet Corps (NCC) Session 2023-24

Introduction:

The NCC in India was formed under the National Cadet Corps Act of 1948. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth – 'The Leaders of Tomorrow' – into disciplined and patriotic citizens. National Cadet Corps (NCC) is a premier youth organization that functions directly under the Ministry of Defence. It functions at National level to train the young boys and girls to be better citizens and future leaders of our country. The motto of NCC is 'Unity and Discipline'. Govt.

P.G. College for Women Rohtak has a strong and vibrant NCC programme which strives to develop leadership, build strength of character, comradeship, spirit of sportsmanship. It has enormous potential for nation building. The NCC is open to all regular students of schools and colleges on a voluntary basis. The students have no liability for active military service.

History of the College NCC: Govt. P.G. College for Women, Rohtak, took the initiative and joined the National Cadet Corps in 1959 to prepare its students for serving the nation. GPGCW is a sub unit of 2 HAR GIRLS BN NCC ROHTAK with two units of 107 cadets of Senior Wing. NCC offers 'B' and 'C' certificates for Senior wing (SW) cadets. The NCC unit of our college is very dynamic and enthusiastic.

Vision and Mission: Our NCC wing's vision is to empower volunteer youth to become potential leader and responsible citizen of the country and our mission is to develop leadership and character qualities, mould discipline, nurture social integration and cohesion through multifaceted programmes conducted in a military environment. The NCC provides opportunities to the youth of the country for their all-round development with a sense of Duty, Commitment, Dedication, Discipline and Moral Values so that they become able leaders and useful citizens. Our NCC units provides exposure to the cadets in a wide range of activities with a distinct emphasis on social services, discipline and adventure training and developing students' character by promoting values such as patriotism, service, discipline, hard work, team spirit, leadership, and self- confidence, as well as overall personality development through participation in various camps and activities throughout the year like Institutional Training, Annual Training Camp, Army Attachment Camp, Republic Day Camp, TSC, Youth Exchange Programme, Community Development Programme cum Social Service Activities, Adventure Training, Cycle Expedition, Trekking & Sports etc.

Training Methodology: Our training methodology basically includes comprehensive training for empowerment of youth to earn the right to lead, module-based training to include character building and competence development, basic military training, social awareness and service. We conduct training in an innovative, interesting, and safe manner with a high degree of visibility in order to inspire youngsters, backed up by suitable training infrastructure and logistics support for cadet.

Institutional Training: Institutional training conducted at Colleges and Schools is the main stay of NCC training and is conducted by Associate NCC Officers and Armed Forces personnel. It includes basic military training to the cadets as part of the curriculum and prepares them to join the Armed Forces. This training is for three years and has 300 periods. In our college, our training lectures are conducted in the evening after the college hours for two days a week. The syllabus comprises common subjects and service subjects in the ratio 70:30. Common subjects are taught by ANO and specialised subjects are taught by Army staff. The purpose of this training is to expose young cadets to a 'regimental way of life' which is essential to inculcate in them the values of discipline, duty, punctuality, orderliness, smartness, respect for the authorities, correct work ethos, and self-confidence.

Annual Training Camp: Annual Training Camp is the practical manifestation of institutional training. It is mandatory for senior wing cadets to attend a minimum of two camps during the period of their enrolment. It is conducted at Battalion level and run by ANOs and Army Personal Staff. In this camp various competitions are conducted like sports, cultural, drill, poster etc. Our cadets participate actively in this camp, and for the last few years, our institution has taken the overall trophy. In this camp our cadets learn practical knowledge of map reading, weapon handling, firing, drill, guard of honour. Our college's cadet team is the best Guard of Honour team of our Battalion.

Republic Day Camp: The Annual Republic Day Camp (RDC) is held at Garrison Parade Ground, Delhi Cantt every year from 01 January to 29 January. It is a national camp and approximately 2000 cadets are selected every year from all States and Union Territories of India. Recently, one of our cadets was selected for this camp and performed very well. Some of cadets reached up to Pre RDC camp. It is a matter of great pride for a cadet to be selected to represent her state in the Republic Day Camp.

Army Attachment Camp: Cadets derive immense value through attachment to the Armed Forces Units where they experience the functioning of military units and life in armed forces units. 440 officers and 20,000 cadets attend attachment training with regular army units annually. Our cadets also get opportunity every year to be part of this camp and basically this camp is helpful for those who want to be part of armed forces. This camp includes weapon training, Map reading, Tent pitching, Rifle shooting by INSAS and LMG rifles, Ambush Demo, Night Navigation, Point to Point march, drill, First Aid training, Adventurous activities like Slithering, Rappelling, Artificial rock climbing etc and also some competitions like Firing and Sports are also conducted. Our cadets have won such competitions and also have active participation in these various activities.

TSC (Thal Sainik Camp): TSC is a 12 days national camp conducted by NCC in Delhi every year, in which the cadets are selected from all 17 directorates (30+3 cadets from each directorate), by the selection procedure conducting 3 Pre-TSC camps each of 10–12 days a week interval. The cadets from our college are also selected for this camp and performed well. The selected cadets are sent to the TSC to represent their respective directorates. This camp includes various competitions such as Obstacle Training, Firing, Judging Distance, Health and Hygiene, Field Signals, Map Reading, Tent Pitching, and Line Area. The cadets will be able to gain a lot of knowledge, self-confidence and leadership qualities as well. Many games and cultural events have taken place during the camps.

YEP (Youth Exchange Program): Youth Exchange Programme is an exchange programme of cadets from one country to other NCC/ equivalent Govt/ youth organizations of friendly countries. The cadets participate in NCC activities of the host country to create an increased awareness and appreciation of each other's socio-economic and cultural realities. NCC has a vibrant YEP with ten countries.

Community Development Programme cum Social Service Activities: Social Service activities are structured to inspire and encourage the cadets to participate voluntarily towards improvement of their physical and social environment and channelize their energies in the task of nation building. Our college organises social service activities every year in the campus and outside the campus. Every cadet participates voluntarily in these activities and even help in organising these events. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Tree Plantation, Anti-Drug Rally, Save Environment, Stop Pollution, Blood Donation, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, AIDS Awareness, Care for the Blind, Care for orphanages and old people in Old Age Homes, Traffic Control, Covid Pandemic Relief etc. are some of the activities that our college organizes. The objectives of Social Service are to teach the cadets the dignity of labour and to create in them an interest in constructive work which will be of use to the community, to set an example of selfless service and team work, to give a lead in organized work, with a view to utilise the maximum possible extent the available unused time, energy and other resources of our people and direct them in various fields of social and economic activity.

Adventure Based Learning: Adventure is the life blood of youth. Adventure training in the NCC provides knowledge to cadets of the topography as well as experience of different weather conditions and adventurous living under camp conditions. The whole aim is to inculcate a spirit of adventure, explorative inquisitiveness, develop stamina, endurance, discipline, courage, determination, comradeship, leadership leading to development of self-confidence, team spirit and spirit-de-corps amongst NCC cadets. NCC cadets are given the opportunity to participate in a host of adventure activities including Mountain Treks and Expeditions, Trekking, Parasailing, Sailing, Scuba Diving, Kayaking, Camel safari, Cycle Expedition etc. Our cadets have participated in trekking and cycling expeditions.

Sports: Our few cadets have participated in national level Shooting Championship (All India GV Mavlankar Shooting Competition), 'Firing' being one of the important training activities of NCC and 'Shooting' having special place in NCC sports activities. 3. Objectives of the Scheme

- I. To providing an opportunity for earning while learning so that spirit of work culture and confidence is inculcated in the students. Concurrently enterprising students would be provided financial support, counseling and a holistic opportunity to learn and plan their careers by awarding individual grants for undertaking a certain kind of study. For this apart from the financial help, a student would be treated as an intern of the State and would be helped extensively by facilitating his/her overall development.
- II. The scheme envisages engaging students in small tasks in the college and outside the college.

- 9 -

Action Plan

A. Activities with in Campus

1. Laboratories: It will inculcate in them a sense of responsibility towards handling, maintenance and up keep of all the equipments, storage of material and other ancillary tasks in the laboratories. For this the preference would be given to the students from science streams so that they can perform their duties along with studies/experimentations. This assistance in laboratory will be in regular college hours.
2. Library: Library Jobs involving them in maintaining and drawing catalogues, arrangement and display of books, stock verification, tasks related to repair of damage books, issue and return of the books at the counter etc.
3. Assistance in the Computer room of the College.
4. Assistance in the office work of the college and any other suitable job in the college campus.

B. Activities Outside the Campus

1. Taking Care of Old Age out person campus homes and Orphan Age.

A group of volunteer students will be formed under the supervision of NSS Programme Officer who will be Nodal Officer of this scheme. The group will comprise NSS Volunteers, YRC Students, NCC Cadets and other dedicated and disciplined students. These students shall take care of minimum one person in Old Age Homes, Orphan Age Homes, Open Shelter Homes and Observation Homes. Nodal Officer will prepare the list of such old age and orphan age persons and allot each of them to every voluntary student. Each such student shall visit these Homes minimum twice a week and may interact with the allotted person telephonically for rest of the days. They shall help in procuring medicines for them and also help in other important work of old age persons or orphans. Students may also be directed to study the challenges of persons living in Old age/orphan age homes and learn from their experiences. A daily report shall be sent to this Directorate through the special Mobile App.

2. Adoption of Libraries at Old Age and Orphan Age Homes

Libraries are proposed to be started in some villages and all Mahagams, blocks, subdivisions and old age & orphanages of Haryana State. A group of volunteer students will be formed to take care of these libraries under the supervision of Youth Red Cross (YRC) Counsellor or NSS Programme Officer. The group will comprise YRC Students, NSS Volunteers and NCC Cadets. Nodal Officer will allot each assigned library to a group of 3 students who shall visit the library for two days each on rotation basis. These students shall take the responsibility to maintain it and send daily report to the Directorate of Higher Education through the special Mobile App.

3. Taking Care of Old Age People in Rural Area and awareness about rural sanitation.

About two third population of India is living in villages. There is a need to aware rural people about hygiene and other important schemes of the Government about their welfare. A group of NSS Volunteers, NCC Cadets, YRC members and other volunteer students from rural area will work under the supervision of NSS/NCC officer who will be Nodal Officer the Scheme. Each such student will take care of at least one old age person living in nearby area or village and send daily report to the Directorate of Higher Education through the special APP.

Selection of Volunteer Students

Selection of volunteer students will be made by a duly constituted committee of the college under the chairmanship of the Principal. Principals are requested to ensure that the priority should be given to the needy students who are disciplined and dedicated.

Reporting System

All the Nodal Officer of the three activities to be carried out the regular reporting and feedback system. Whatsapp group for each of the above activities may be formed by the Nodal Officers for the smooth functioning.

4. **Authority competent to draw the amount**
Principal of the concerned College.

5. **Authority to sanction the benefit**
Principal of the concerned College.

6. **Procedure of the payment**

Amount will be allotted by the Directorate after receiving strength of the students. Principal will disburse the amount through NTF/ADDHAR.

7. **Method of keeping Accounts**

The cash book is being maintained by the concerned college and monitored by the Deputy Director NPE in the Directorate.

8. **Time frame of the scheme**

20% upto September, 2023

40% upto November, 2023

60% upto December, 2023

100% upto March, 2024

9. **Eligibility Conditions/Selection criteria**

The selection criteria for the scheme would be to invite application from the students of all the classes along with bio-data to be finalized by a Committee headed by Principal consisting of 2 Associate Professors of the College.

10. **Modus Operandi of selection of beneficiaries**

Through applications from students and selection there off by a Committee constituted by the Principal of concerned college.

11. **Guidelines**

The Principal will adhere to the following guidelines:-

1. The students will be engaged for - office, lab, library, IT related works and in community services.
2. The students should be engaged by a Committee headed by Principal consisting of 2 Associate Professors of the College.
3. The meritorious students be given priority over the others and thereafter Principal may ensure that the priority should be given to the needy students.
4. The students will be engaged in case there is need of engaging students due to shortage of staff.
5. Per hour payment to the students should be duly verified by the HOD of the concerned Department/office and certified by the committee constituted thereof.

12. **Pattern of assistance**

For all these jobs students would be paid @ Rs. 100/- per hour (maximum number of six hours to be permitted per week per students i.e. Rs. 600/- per week per student) so that a student can earn up to Rs. 2400/- per month.

13. **Utilization of the sanctioned budget at the headquarter level shall be monitoring by Deputy Director NPE.**


