


1. How do you evaluate the syllabus taught to your students.

2. How do you evaluate the internal assessment process of students?




3. How frequently do you identify the strength and weakness of students in mentor-mentee groups?




4. How do you evaluate the availability of reference books and study material for students? 120 responses




5. Do you think co-curricular activities supplement the syllabus.


6. How do you evaluate sufficiency of contact hours stated in syllabus to complete the coverage of syllabus?




7. How do you rate the linkage between the syllabus and contemporary global and national scenario.



Brief summary

Almost all the teachers evaluated the syllabus taught to students as either excellent or very good. Only 2.5% marked it 'average'. 94.1% teachers agreed that the internal assessment process is appropriate. During the mentor-mentee classes, they try very frequently to identify the strength and weakness of their students. 81.6% faculty members believe that co-curricular activities supplement the syllabus. Approx. 87.5% teachers said that they have sufficient contact hours to complete the syllabus. 90.8% responses have been received in favour of the linkage of syllabus with the contemporary Global and National scenarios. Around 79.1% teachers believe that the current syllabus taught to the students makes them employable. Most of the staff members are satisfied with the adequacy of ICT facilities available in the college. Thus, overall a very positive response has been received from the faculty of the institute.

Suggestions

Overall, a good response of appreciation was found for all the parameters related to the teaching learning process, curriculum contents and availability of infrastructure. However, in order to move ahead toward the perfection level, suggestions from all the teaching fraternity is always welcome. Few suggestions regarding updating the syllabus as per market needs and implementing NEP were received. Most teaching faculty suggested updating the syllabus, and organising seminars/ workshops etc. These suggestions were forwarded to the concerned authorities for necessary action
